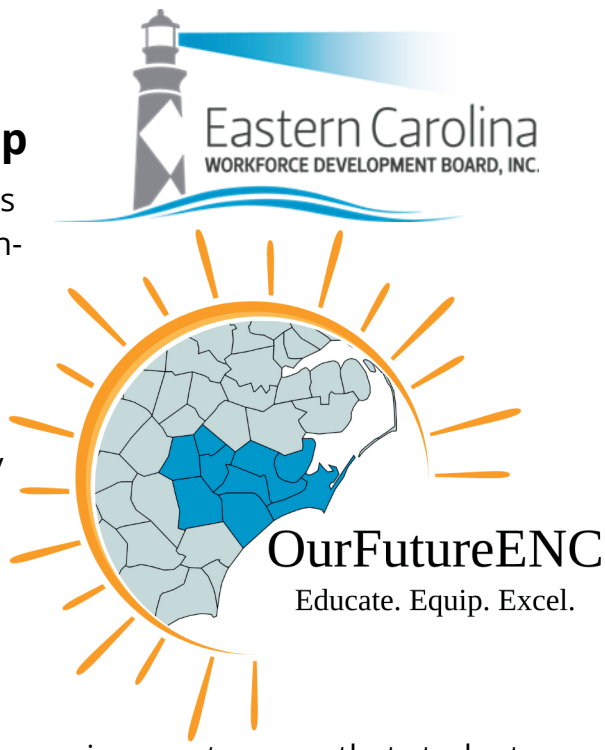

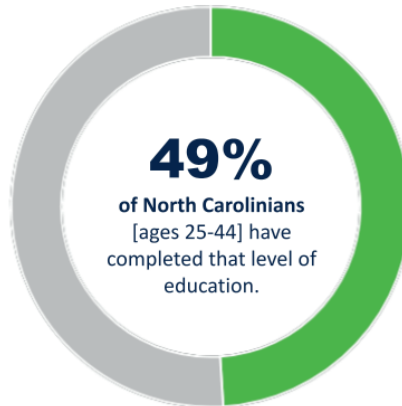
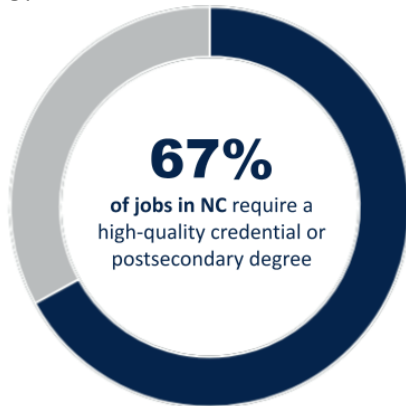
How important is a high quality credential or postsecondary degree?

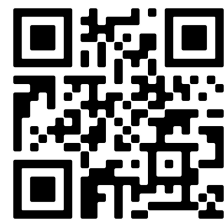
